Join us at our March 22th meeting to meet Jessica Ruthenberg, Chesapeake-based watchable wildlife biologist for the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. Jessica serves the entire coastal plan of Virginia and also acts as statewide coordinator of the Virginia Birding and Wildlife Trail. We have moved to the Pretlow Library, 111 W. Ocean View Ave., Norfolk, VA 23503 due to LanternAsia at NBG. The social begins at 6:30 and the meeting will start at 7:00 PM.

A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT

You would not think it early spring with the snow we had mid-March. I have had azaleas (non-native) blooming for a couple weeks; trilliums came up over the second weekend in March and columbine ready to open the buds. Many of the trees have already bloomed too.

We went to the VNPS Winter Workshop in Richmond over the weekend. The focus was on trees. We so often fail to see the forest or the trees...a backdrop to the showy perennials and shrubberies we covet. John Seiler went over the physics of trees, how they drag water up their trunks by the demands of the leaves.
