BLUE RIDGE WILDFLOWER SOCIETY

Buffalo Creek Nature Area	Property has been sold; the new owner has implied by his actions little interest in a Registry Site. No recent information.

Bear Garden	Owner died; heirs uncertain in their interest toward continuing as a Registry Site.

PIEDMONT

Calmes Neck Bluffs	Inspection for 2013 completed and report submitted - situation stable.
Carter Run Wetlands	No recent inspection.
G. Richard Thompson WMA	No recent inspection; new sign in place by VDGIF.

POTOWMACK

Arlington House Woods	A cemetery modification to provide more burial sites is probably underway. Efforts by a coalition of conservation groups achieved only minor design changes; net effects on site hopefully minor.

Great Falls National Park

Visit in May 2013 showed the park is in good shape and heavily used. No inspection report.

Huntely Meadows Park

The wetland restoration project was completed in May 2014. Visit by Natural Heritage Program staff in July 2014. Continued natural resource management and monitoring by site staff and volunteers.

Riverbend Park

Park condition stable and well cared for. Site natural resource management plan updated.

Runnymeade Park

Public park in Herndon, VA. In 2013, park was in good shape, with an active friends organization. Invasives evident but not dominant.

Scotts Run Nature Preserve

This park has no facilities, so exists only for conservation. For the number of visitors, the park is in fairly good shape. Upland forest significantly impacted from deer browse. Rare plants and communities in Potomac River floodplain in pretty good condition.

Turkey Run National Park

The Nature Conservancy and its "Weed Warriors" are not currently active, but did work several years on removal of Linden viburnum, etc. Inspection and report in August 2013 reported good condition.

PRINCE WILLIAM WILDFLOWER SOCIETY

James Long Park - Delisted

Delisted as recommended by chapter due to total loss of habitat caused by development and no care.

Manassas National Battlefield Park

PWWS members working with MNBPF staff on maintenance/mowing cycles for Deep Cut. Multiple visits in July & August 2014. Meadow in good condition but concerns over *Panicum virgatum*, *Andropogon gerardii* and *Sorghum halepense* populations. Data plot surveys to begin under NPS permit 2015.

Merrimac Farm WMA

Site in good condition overall. Bluebell stands and upland forested areas stable. New forested wetlands discovered June 2014, and site plant list expanded. PWWs working with VDGIF and Prince William Conservation Alliance on inventory and management issues.

SHENANDOAH

Mueller Marsh/Folly Mills Creek NAP

Report in 2010 showed that this NAP was in good shape, with some uncertainty due to the advancing age of owner. We do not know the arrangement with the state of VA. No recent report.
