We Appreciate Your Plant & Seed Donations

for the WRL Fall Plant Share and Seed Exchange!

Our focus for the Fall Plant Share is on outdoor plants. However, we also welcome house plant cuttings and seeds for the WRL Seed Exchange.

For plants, please donate:

- Healthy potted plants or house plant cuttings that are free from disease and pests, accompanied by a completed seed donation form.
- Plants should be neatly potted in soil. Reusable plastic pots or recycled items (e.g., yogurt cups for seedlings, the bottom half of cardboard or plastic milk, juice or water containers) used as pots are recommended.
- Fresh house plant cuttings should be in damp paper towels or a container of water.

We cannot accept:

- Plants that appear diseased or have pests.
- Plants that are toxic to children or pets if ingested or touched.
- Plants that are invasive non-natives in Virginia. These quickly grow and outcompete our native plants which provide better wildlife habitat.
- Divisions of patented varieties of plants. Although it is legal for gardeners to grow and divide patented varieties, it is illegal to distribute them.
- Plants that are illegal.

For seeds, please donate:

- Fully dried seeds that you have collected from your healthy plants, accompanied by a completed seed donation form.
- Extra seeds that you purchased but did not need.
- Seed packets that you have purchased to donate.

We cannot accept:

- Seeds from plants that are toxic to children or pets if ingested or touched.
- Seeds from plants that are invasive non-natives in Virginia.
- Seeds from hybrid plants because their seeds won't produce the same plants.
- Seeds from patented varieties of plants.
- Seeds that are illegal.
