Join us at our May 24th meeting to meet Dustie Bourgeois from the Virginia Aquarium. Dustie will be giving us insight to native plants at the Aquarium where she manages 46 acres of natural habitat as well as indoor exhibits containing live plants. We are back at the Norfolk Botanical Gardens and in the Holly Room. LanternAsia is still going on, but we have been assured that our meeting will be accommodated. The social begins at 6:30 and the meeting will start at 7:00 PM.

## A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT

This year we went from Winter to Summer in just a couple weeks. Some of the plants have been confused...our striped wintergreen is blooming; partridgeberry is either blooming or with lots of buds; the dogwood did not have nearly any blooms this year and everything came up later than normal. Our April plant sale was awesome and May worked out well too, we grossed nearly \$1300 and netted around \$500 in May. We sold nearly all our inventory...Pat Quinn will baby sit most of the pots until the Master Gardener event at AREC on September 15. I took home 40 plugs and potted them up...if they look fabulous in the fall they will join us at the AREC Master Gardeners sale...otherwise "better luck next year". We grossed \$7800 from the two sales, and, with costs less than that we probably netted nearly \$2000. Thanks for every helper for the May sale!...Pat Quinn for doing the leg work and purchasing; Beth Richardson; Vickie Shufer; Amy Jones; Sandy Ricks; Brooke Schaab, Peggy Toney, Kathleen Stasulis (and I was there as well). If I missed anyone who was there I apologize. We could probably use help at the September sale; Kathleen and I are unable to be there due to several conflicts in September! If the weather is nice we will sell posters, books and cards as well.
